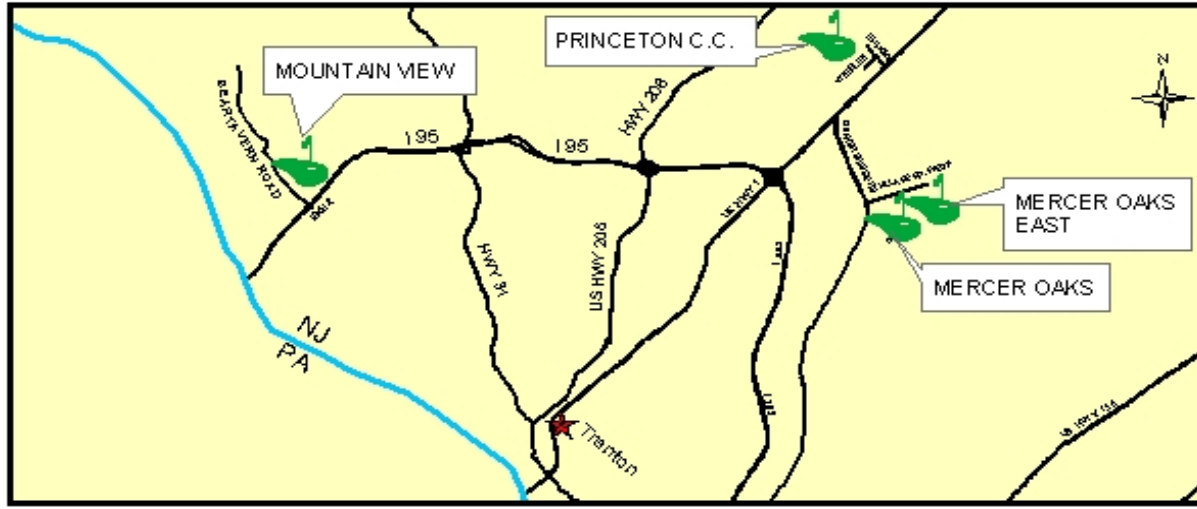


Mercer County Golf Courses Map

Golf Etiquette

Mercer County requests each golfer's help to keep the pace of play at a reasonable rate. Each golfer is asked to repair ball marks on the greens and divots on tees, fairways and the rough. Rake any foot prints in the bunkers. Non-metal spikes only. Proper attire is required at all times. No tank tops and cutoff jeans are permitted. Golfers of all abilities should abide by the universal rules of golf etiquette.

Golf Season Information

Mercer Oaks and Mercer Oaks East are closed during the winter. Mountain View and Princeton Country Club are open all year weather permitting. During the winter season call the pro shop for current conditions of the course. The course opening and twilight times vary at all golf courses throughout the golf season. Please call each respective golf course pro shop for the current schedule.

Mercer County Golf ID Cards

All Mercer County residents are eligible for discounted greens fees and access to the automated tee time service after purchasing Mercer county's Golf ID Card. New ID Cards are issued at Mercer Oaks and Mt View proshop only, However they can be renewed at any of our golf course proshop. In order to purchase a resident Golf ID card, prospective golfers must reside in Mercer County and provide one of the following, showing current address as a proof of residency:

1. Current N.J. Driver's License with photo or N.J. Driver License without photo along with vehicle registration.
2. Current Property tax bill along with sewage utility bill.
3. Junior resident must show their birth certificate and accompanied by their resident parent.

Non County residents can purchase a reservation ID Card in order to access Mercer county's tee time system .

Mercer Oaks Golf Course is an 18 hole championship golf course designed by Ault, Clark and Associates which opened to the public in 1991. The course is a part of the landscape of Mercer County Park and Lake Mercer. It is a links type course with large greens and bunkers. Through strategic design and careful placement of bunkers and other hazards, the course provides a good test of golf. From the championship tees, the course measures over 7,000 yards with a par of 72.

Amenities: State of the art grass practice/range facility, a 300 yard driving range and large putting greens. Mercer Oaks is managed by a class “A” PGA golf professional , who offers professional advice for golf equipments and lessons. The clubhouse offers a full service restaurant & bar and banquet facilities for all occasions. For dinning and banquet information call (609) 490-0500.

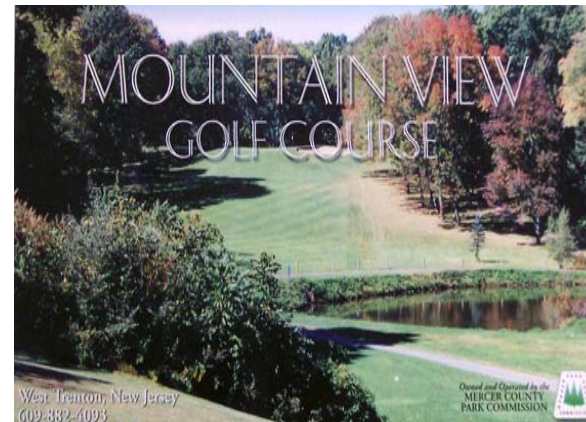

Mercer Oaks East Golf Course is designed by Ault, Clark and Associates which opened to the public in the fall of 2003. From the championship tees, the course measures 7,182 yards with a par of 72.

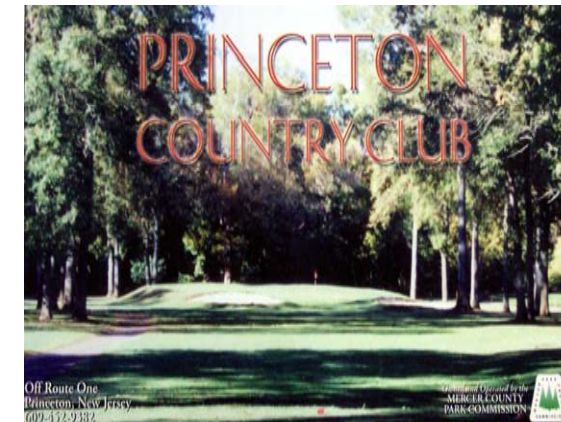

Princeton Country Club is an 18 hole championship golf course was designed by William Gordon in late 50’s. Princeton is open year round, seven days a week. Open weather permitting during winter season. Princeton’s fairways are totally tree lined and the course is divided by the Delaware Raritan Canal. Princeton offers play on a first come first serve basis. The course measures 5,845 yards from the regular tees with a par of 70.
